## 2025-2026 FINANCIAL AID CHECKLIST

- 1. New students must apply for admission to Troy University at <a href="troy.edu/admissions">troy.edu/admissions</a> and be admitted before any aid will be processed or awarded.
- 2. Next, go to the Federal Student Aid website at <u>studentaid.gov</u> and create an account and an FSA ID. An FSA ID is comprised of a username and password and can be used to login to certain Federal Student Aid websites, such as the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Your FSA ID can be used to sign your FAFSA electronically. If you are a parent and need to sign your child's FAFSA electronically, you will also need your own FSA ID.
- 3. All students must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) every award year. Use Federal School Code Number 001047 for all Troy University sites and locations. You may apply online at <u>studentaid.gov</u> after October 1st for the upcoming academic year. If you graduate high school in 2025, you should complete the 2025-2026 FAFSA.
- 4. Upon receipt of your FAFSA, if you have been admitted to Troy University, you will be notified via your TROY email for any additional information we may require to complete your financial aid application at Troy University.
- 5. Remember, financial aid is never renewed automatically, so make sure you submit a new FAFSA every academic year.
