C. Verification of 2024 IRS Income Tax Return Information for Student Tax Filers

Instructions: Complete this section if the student and spouse filed or will file a 2024 IRS income tax return(s). *The best way to verify income is by using the* using the FUTURE Act Direct Data Exchange (FA-DDX) that transfers IRS federal tax information (FTI) to the FAFSA on the Web. In most cases, no further documentation is needed to verify 2024 IRS income tax return information that was transferred into the student's FAFSA using the FA-DDX if that information was not changed by the FAFSA filer.

- Paper Request Form – IRS Form 4506T-EZ or IRS Form 4506-T
